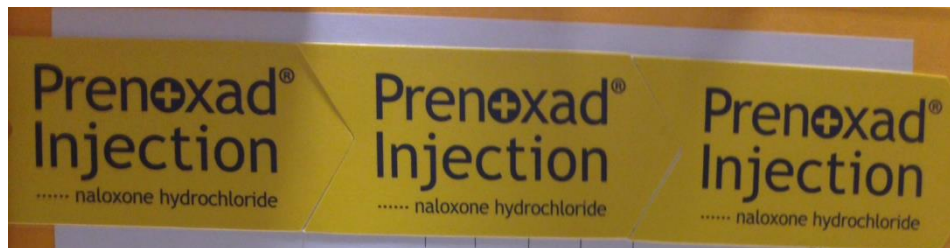


## Naloxone Take Home Training for Pharmacists and Pharmacy Assistants
