GP-CPCS: Local Process in Hertfordshire (EMIS)



The patient contacts the surgery.
The surgery identifies that the condition is one that is suitable for treatment by a community pharmacist.





Surgery refers the patient via EMIS (into PharmOutcomes) to the preferred pharmacy.





Patient notified of contact from pharmacy within agreed timescales (4 working hours).

Pharmacist need to proactively contact the patient.





The pharmacist assesses the patient and undertakes the consultation via:

- face to face
- telephone
- video

Red Flag / Emergency?





The pharmacist calls surgery via professional line (restricted use for GP-CPCS only).





Patient notified of next steps by relevant individual (receptionist or pharmacist).





Information recoded on PharmOutcomes.
The surgery receives a Post Event Notification.
