# GP-CPCS: Local Processes in Hertfordshire



The patient contacts the surgery. The surgery identifies that the condition is one that is suitable for treatment by a community pharmacist.





Surgery refers the patient via Arden template (to nhs.net mailbox) to the preferred pharmacy.





Patient notified of contact from pharmacy within agreed timescales (4 working hours). Pharmacist needs to proactively contact the patient.





The pharmacist assesses the patient and undertakes the consultation via:

- face to face
- telephone
- video





Pharmacy inputs information into PharmOutcomes. The surgery receives a Post Event Notification.
