Denise Rabbette registered as a Pharmacist in 1996 and began her career as a Community Pharmacist before completing a clinical diploma and moving into primary care and community services. She supported the Metropolitan Police to develop PGDs for use by nurses in custody suites before accepting a position as the Head of Medicines Management where she developed a support structure for non medical prescribers and embedded protected time in the workplace for reflective practice.

In 2015 she qualified as a prescriber and this led to the development of clinics for pain and atrial fibrillation management within GP practices. This opportunity then led to a position as an associate lecturer at the Medway School of Pharmacy.

In 2016 she returned to a role as the Head of Medicines Optimisation taking responsibility for ensuring that the CCG commissions pathways and treatments that have clinical and cost effectiveness at their heart. Medicines Optimisation is about ensuring people get the right choice of medicines, at the right time, and are engaged in the process by their clinical team.

This year she has moved into teaching postgraduate and undergraduate students at Medway School of Pharmacy but has retained an NHS role working as a senior practice pharmacist in a large practice in Basildon.
