Good Practice

- Break into bite size chunks
- Empower a key staff member to own the process
- Identify those items that are the 'day job' (ensure they are being completed routinely)
- Keep copies of all training certificates to hand
- Keep all PQS evidence in a folder
- Don't leave everything to the last minute
- Work out how much is at stake financially for your business (average Pharmacy is £6,750)
- Link to campaigns etc where possible (e.g. weight management)
- Ensure certain items become routine all year e.g. NMS



Gateway Criteria

(Must be achieved by 31/03/2023 to claim quality criteria)

NMS

- 20 completed
- Claimed by 5/4/23

Patient Safety

- Record incidents and what you have done to resolve them on the monthly form. (Near miss, dispensing errors significant interventions)
- Transfer these to the annual report
- Add any additional actions you have taken to resolve/prevent further issues.



Quality Domains

- Risk Management and Safeguarding Band 2-6 = 25 points
- Respiratory Points dependent on prescription volume (Max 33.3 points)
- Healthy Living support Band 2-6 20 points (10 points for intervention + 10 points for referral)
- Prevention Band 2-6 20 points
- Addressing unwanted variation in care Band 2-6 10 points



Risk Management and Safeguarding

Update the risk review from 21/22 or Complete a new Risk review

Review to include:

- Risk of missing Sepsis identification
- Missing Red Flag symptoms during OTC consultations
- Minimising risk of Covid transmission



Risk Management and Safeguarding

Training

- Sepsis since April 2021 (update every two years)
- Risk Management guide and e-assessment
- Safeguarding Level 3 (Webinar)
- Domestic Abuse prevention
 - Safe Spaces training and quiz
 - Ask for ANI and Safe Spaces schemes: training toolkit
 - read and understood the <u>Safe Spaces Set-up Toolkit</u>



Respiratory

- Record children aged 5-15 have an asthma plan in place and how many have a spacer where required
- Record the total number of children aged 5 to 15 referred to a prescriber for a spacer device
- Record number of patients identified who were prescribed a new inhaler and offered an NMS.
- Record number of NMSs provided face-to-face and number of virtual including inhaler technique training.
- Record number of patients referred to prescriber after conducting NMS.



Respiratory continued

- Record the number of patients referred to prescriber with issues identified during NMS
- Record the total number of patients with asthma, for whom three or more bronchodilator inhalers were dispensed without any corticosteroid inhaler within a six-month period and who were referred to an appropriate healthcare professional for an asthma review by the day of the declaration.
- Record number of returns of unwanted and used inhalers

Training

- Inhaler technique training completed and April 2020 e-assessment completed

Healthy Living support

Weight Management

- Discuss weight management with a min of 25 people and refer a min of 4 people to either NHS Digital or Local Authority tier 2 weight management service
- Complete action plan
- Record number of people who had their BMI calculated and explained
- Record number of people who were referred to <u>Local Authority tier 2 weight</u> <u>management service</u>
- Record number of people who were referred to <u>NHS digital weight</u> management service

Training

Complete weight Management training if not previously completed



Prevention

Antimicrobial Stewardship

 Review 15 patients over a 4-week period presenting without a prescription for a suspected UTI and 15 for a suspected upper respiratory infection.

(If minimum for each condition not achieved in 4 weeks continue for 8 weeks)

- Record start and end date.
- Share anonymised data with NHS England via MYS. Review previous action plan or produce new plan. Changed SOP to incorporate target leaflets into dayto-day practice

Training

Complete training for either registered or non-registered staff. (within period 2020-2023)



Prevention continued

Cancer Awareness

- Confirm that the risk review includes plans to minimise the risk of missing suspected cancer symptoms
- Total number of patients referred to a GP following detection of red flag signs and symptoms of suspected cancer

Module 1 of <u>Let's Communicate Cancer</u> (early diagnosis and prevention) training and quiz completed



Addressing unwanted variation in care

Palliative and End of Life Action Plan

- Confirm if the pharmacy does or does not stock the 16 palliative and end of life critical medicines
- If yes update NHS Profile Manager to confirm (To be completed as soon as possible after the 16/1/23 and by 31/3/23)
- Everyone must complete an action plan that shows you are able to signpost patients or their carers/relatives to a pharmacy holding the stock
- Pharmacies commissioned for the immediate access to emergency medicines is available here: <u>East and North Herts</u> / <u>South and West Herts</u>
- This plan must be available for inspection



Training Requirements

- Training to be completed by 31/3/2023
- Certificates to be available if requested
- Ensure training up to date
- Ensure relevant staff have completed training for their role
- Have plans in place to train any new staff in the future where possible

- 1 Please note, for the 2023/24 PQS, registered pharmacy professionals will be required to have completed the CPPE Risk management guide and passed the e-assessment within four years prior to 31st March 2024 (between 1st April 2020 and 31 March 2024). This requirement was due to be introduced in the 2022/23 PQS, but due to the start date of the scheme being delayed, it has been agreed to delay this requirement until the 2023/24 Scheme.
- 2 If you attended the live recording of this webinar on 30th June 2022 and have the certificate of attendance, you have met this training requirement.
- 3 Staff members, who have been affected by domestic abuse and do not wish to undertake the Safe Spaces training and quiz, are exempt from completing it.
- 4 Pharmacists can complete this e-learning or attend a CPPE inhaler technique face-to-face inhaler technique workshop (if available).
- 5 There is no set training for the return of unwanted and used inhalers; however, PSNC has produced a factsheet (available at psnc.org.uk/pqs) which contractors can use to meet this training requirement.
- 6 Contractors may also have other staff that can be identified as having patient-facing roles.
- 7 If you have completed the BOPA Let's Communicate Cancer series on the BOPA website since 31st March 2021 and have you certificate of completion, you have met this training requirement.

Funding

- Respiratory has a designated maximum number of points dependent on total prescription volume in according to the NHSBSA's payment data.
- All other domains, realise a fixed payment.
- Funding will be divided between qualifying pharmacies based on the number of points achieved.
- Maximum £135 per point.
- Minimum value per point of £67.50
- Total funding for PQS 2022/23 is £75 million.
