The NICE recommends that people living with diabetes have the following 9 annual checks:

Body mass index (BMI)

2 Urinary albumin test

3 Blood pressure

4 Serum creatinine test

5 Smoking status

6 Cholesterol levels

7 HbAlc measurement

8 Foot check

9 Eye check (retinopathy screening)*

With the right training and clinical supervision, unregistered healthcare staff can be supported to efficiently deliver 8 of these diabetes care processes.

*Retinal screening needs to be done by appropriately trained staff with suitable retinal photography equipment.
