What people can expect:

- Provision of immediate safety advice to prevent and minimize harm to individuals and their families.
- Completion of Domestic Abuse, Stalking and 'Honour' Based Abuse (DASH) risk assessment.
- Discussion of individual needs to be matched and referred to appropriate Community Outreach Services where risk is standard or medium.
- Any high-risk cases identified will be referred straight to Multi-Agency Risk Assessment Conference (MARAC) & Independent Domestic Violence Advisors
- Provision of advice and guidance if an assessment is not required.
- Translation services are available to those who do not have English as a first language. Please let us know the preferred language.

WHO CAN USE THE HUB?

Members of the public can self-refer and professionals not trained or able to assess domestic abuse risk can call about people who need this support.

We welcome calls from people regardless of gender, race/ethnic origin, religious belief, disability or sexual orientation.
