# SS26 Training overview

Due to the significant changes expected for the SS26 campaign, NHS England will be running a comprehensive training schedule from Monday 23 February 2026, through to Wednesday 11 March 2026, covering 14 individual sessions, including some evenings.

This will include dedicated drop-in sessions for anyone having FDP access issues, along with detailed live training for all Providers, GP Practice-specific sessions, Regional & ICB sessions, and one devoted for Detained Estates colleagues.

Live training sessions will cover:

- How the new provider-led vaccine supply model works
- Your site's campaign entitlement and how allocations are released
- How to order vaccine and select delivery dates through FDP
- Stocktake requirements and compliance
- Practical demonstrations of FDP applications

The National team plan to continue holding weekly drop-in sessions following the comprehensive training schedule, to support colleagues with any ongoing issues. These will be running from April through til May (or beyond, if required), to ensure all users' development needs are supported effectively.
